Pool lighting tips

“A swimming pool is often the focal point for any outdoor entertainment area, and making use of pool lights in and around this area reduces limitations on entertaining or swimming after the sun has gone down. Having adequate pool lighting will add ambiance to any outdoor setting, as well as provide safety for guests, children and visiting family,” explains Melissa Davidson from leading local lighting supplier, The Lighting Warehouse.

These units offer three useful functions in one unit — offering a streamlined and space-saving aesthetic. They come with a switch, which allows individual operation and control of each of the three functions,” concludes Davidson.

She notes that many pool owners have opted to replace their built-in incandescent pool lights with LED globes instead: “Aside from being environmentally friendly, LED lights last longer. They might cost a little more to purchase initially, but their comparatively low energy consumption will end up saving you money in the long run. For a more dramatic effect, The Lighting Warehouse offers special LED pool globes that come with a remote control, whereby you can change from the normal cool white setting to a 14-colour-changing setting to create a kind of underwater light show.”

For immediately outside or next to the pool, Davidson suggests the following: “Recessed ground lights set in tiled or decking areas are exceptionally attractive and functional to boot — they are available with either CFL or LED globes. For the garden or rockery immediately surrounding the pool, waterproof garden spike lights are the ideal solution — they are safe, quick and easy to install. These too are available with either CFL or LED globes. Of course, you can also choose from a wide variety of other outdoor light fittings to provide general lighting to your outdoor entertainment area, which could include lanterns, mini posts and poles, hanging lanterns, wall lights and floodlights or example.”
